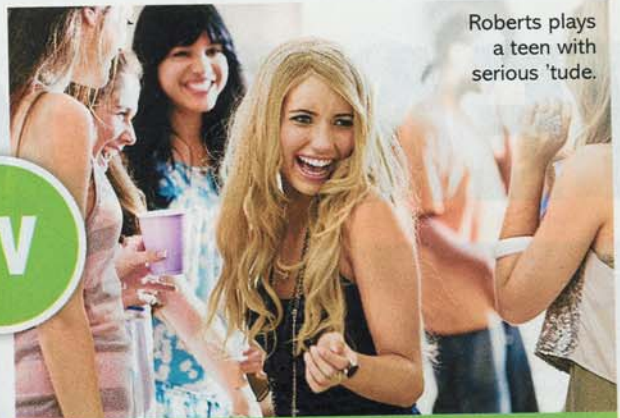


Lovable Brad steps up to become Rachel's new right-hand man.
